"The Walk to Emmaus" Luke 24 13-35 Two of Jesus' followers were on the road to Emmaus after his death, and were sad and downcast. So sad, that they didn't even recognise Him when he drew alongside them. In verse 21 are the words "And we had hoped......"

How many times have we used the words "And we had hoped......" in our own lives??
